# EV Search Enhancements

## Feature Description

Enterprise Vault 12.3 includes a number of enhancements to EV Search:

- Provide the ability to navigate through EV Search result hits so that users can find matching content easily without scrolling.
- Search Suggestion improvements.
- Allow administrators to restore items from journal archives to end user mailboxes.
- Provide end users with the ability to perform actions such as exporting, refiling, restoring and deleting on a larger number of items (500 instead of 200).


## Business Value

End users will benefit from a number of enhancements in the EV 12.3 release, see guided tour section for individual feature benefits.

## Guided Tour

### Hit Highlighting

Hit Highlighting enables the user to find searched keywords faster by highlighting the text in a color of the user's choice (Figure 1).




Figure 2 – New Hit Highlighting Navigation in Reading Preview

The feature further enhances to end user experience by being able to navigate instances of the text found in the archived item (Figure 2).

### Search Suggestion Enhancements

End users will see a number of enhancements around search suggestions.





Figure 3 – Search Suggestions: Date

Firstly, when typing “date”, the user is presented with a few simple choices (Figure 3).


## EV Search Enhancements

When typing in “Filetype” in the search box, the following options are presented to help narrow the search (Figure 4).




**Figure 5 – Search Suggestions: Size**

When typing “size” in the search box, the user is presented with several options (Figure 5).


### Restore an item from Journal Archive to Exchange Mailbox

The Enterprise Vault Administrator can now restore an item directly from the Journal Archive to a particular end user mailbox. This feature is particularly useful in the event of accidental deletion. Figure 6 and 7 shows the restore dialog window.

### Perform bulk action on 500 items




Figure 8 – Bulk actions can now be performed on up to 500 items

Prior to Enterprise Vault 12.3, user could only perform bulk action on up to 200 items. This limit has now been increased to 500. Figure 8 shows a screenshot of the options (configuration dependent) end users will be able to apply to items in bulk.
